IN THE MIDGET DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIP GAME THE #2 SEED LAS VEGAS COWBOYS DEFEATED THE #1 SEED PHASE 1 FUTURES 26-14 AT LIBERTY HS

The Las Vegas Cowboys were in the saddle most of the afternoon as they managed to defeat ride past the Phase 1 Futures in a battle of the undefeated teams here with the Cowboys emerging with the victory and the title of Nevada State Champions. Jeremiah Hughes not only took home the Most Valuable Player award at halftime of the game, but also scored 3 touchdowns to power the LV Cowboys to great championship win. The Cow Pokes got on their horses early and scored on a 1-yard plunge by Jeremiah Hughes for a 7-0 lead. In a wild 2nd quarter the Futures scored on a 1 yard plunge by star runner De Von Rice for a 6-6 tie. The Futures made a 2-point conversion on a 5-yard pass to Bowe Bowler from QB Michael Tollefson for an 8-7 lead. The Cowboys came right back with Jeremiah Hughes scoring on a nifty 50 yard run for a 13-8 lead. A short time later the Cowboys scored again on a 25-yard TD pass to Cam Brooks from QB Jeremiah Hughes for a 20-8 lead. The Futures answered right back on an excellent 50-yard TD pass to Neal Anderson from Jack Cook and the Cowboys led 20-14. Just before halftime the Cowboys scored on a 51 yard run by Jeremiah Hughes for a 26-14 lead. The second half was all defenses as the Cowboys wranglers had the Futures offense corralled to preserve the victory 26-14. The Cowboys offense rushed for 238 yards behind excellent blocking by their offensive line. Jeremiah Hughes led the attack with 130 yards rushing and Jalen Banks added 55 yards rushing. The Cowboys defense was led by Malachi Williams with 3 QB sacks and 9 tackles. Jeremiah Hughes made 7 tackles as did Colin Kirkpatrick for the Cowboys. The Futures offense rushed for 115 yards with De Von Rice gaining 91 yards. QB Michael Tollefson completed 7 of 19 passes for 101 yards and Jack Cook had 6 receptions for 74 yards. For the Futures defense DeVon Rice and Ryan Harden each recovered fumbles. Harden also made 6 tackles and Rice and Bowe Bowler had 5 each for the Futures. The Cowboys complete a perfect regular season and get to take home the Nevada State Championship in the Midget Division behind a tremendous team effort. The Futures come up just short, but have plenty to be proud of after a tremendous showing of their own.

MVP finalist Jeremiah Hughes had a giant game scoring 4 touchdowns in leading the Las Vegas Cowboys into the Midget division championship next Saturday as they managed to ride hard past their rivals in the Henderson Bearcats this weekend. Hughes scored on runs of 20, 3, 20, and 31 yards. Also scoring for the Cowboys was Jaylin Morrison on a 20 yard run.
