Desert Oasis Diamondbacks (2-0) VS Las Vegas Union (2-0) – 7U

It's been the Keenan Thomas Show so far in the 7U Division. Thomas has 7 TD's in the first 2 Games to lead the Desert Oasis Diamondbacks to a fast 2-0 start. Desert Oasis has combined for over 500 yards of offense while only allowing 47 total combined yards and zero points in the first 2 weeks. The Union comes into Desert Oasis with a perfect 2-0 record themselves. They've spread the ball around a bit more amongst their 4 main players in Kareem Knox, Frank Starks, Terrell Collins, and Aisek Brown. They picked up 3 fumbles and held TMT Elite to just 6 points on 70 total yards. The Pahrump Trojans were sensational this past weekend. Last week, they evened up their record with a big win over the Arbor View Aggies, 34-0. Hit Squad have a lot of weapons and get a lot of players involved on offense. They had 5 different players score TD's last week. The Sun Devils have one of the best coaching staffs in youth football at making adjustments on the fly. In their opening weekend victory they gave up just 60 total yards. The Sun Devils will try to put the ball in Justin Russell's hands and let him attack the Falcons defense. All-World MVP RB Donavyn Pellott has been running through NYS defenses since he was old enough to walk. He can run, catch, and even pass. He has a chance to be one of the best youth football players to ever come out of NYS. He's complimented well by QB Branko Hansell-Fotu. Together, they make a very dangerous duo for opposing teams. The Red Eagles opened their season last week with a solid victory over the Raiders. They established their running game early and picked up 168 yards on the ground to soar to a win. More importantly, they forced 2 fumbles.
